Sub: GIDM launches 5 hours basic (introductory) self-paced e-course on Disaster Risk Management (DRM)

Gujarat Institute of Disaster Management (GIDM) is registered as an autonomous society under the Government of Gujarat. The Institute has been entrusted with the responsibility of human resource development, capacity building, training, research and documentation in the field of Disaster Risk Management (DRM). With the advent of Sendal Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction (SFDRR 2015 - 2030), there has been a paradigm shift from 'Managing Disasters' to 'Disaster Risk Management'. Along with this, the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development (Sustainable Development Goals) is steering our world towards sustainable development as an overarching agreement amongst all the nations. The English course is already available on NeGD LMS and the Gujarati course would be available in few days' time. We are indeed very grateful for pro-active support from NeGD.

In addition to this, GIDM is also developing self-paced online 30 hours (2-credit) and 42 hours (3-credit) courses which are envisaged to be regular credit courses for Universities. Further, 42 hours course would be lunched as Bended Certificate course by GIDM.

GIDM would like to take this opportunity to request you to kindly share this valuable information amongst all your staffs and networks, requesting them to go through this course. Further, your suggestions are also invited to make the course more fruitful.
