The following arrangements are to be done by various departments.

- **Police** : The Police must confirm the route of the VVIP visit at the point of entry into district till the departure. Traffic must be controlled since morning. Barricade must be provided wherever necessary. Enough parking space must be made available for the public.
- **Fire Force** : Necessary fire force must be provided both at Arthat and Kannara.
- **District Medical Officer** : Ambulance with all modern facility must accompany the VVIP from the entry point of district to the departure point of the district.
- **Deputy Director of Education** : Schools in the area must be given direction to make arrangements, not to send the school vehicles through Kannara at the time of VVIP Visit.

The District Collector also directed the Deputy Collector (DM) to give necessary information to KSEB and Kerala Water Authority to maintain uninterrupted power supply and water supply at the venues.

Meeting concluded at 3.00 p.m.



As per the communication received so far from government the VVIP will arrive in the Thrissur boundary at Kottappuram, Kodungallur at 10.00 a.m and Arthat church in Kunnankulam at 1.00 p.m and he will have lunch there. He will reach at Kannara at 4.00 p.m as per the latest information. There will be more than 10,000 participants at Arthat. Hence, the District Collector asked District Police Chief (Rural) to look into the matters on the conducting of ceremony with utmost security as per VVIP measures. Sri. M. P. Vincent, MLA informed that 20,000 devotees are expected at Kannara. The Programme is to receive the VVIP at Kannara bridge and after that welcome the VVIP to the church hall. It was also informed that there will be other delegate Bishops from outside India also. Devotees will include peoples from other districts.
